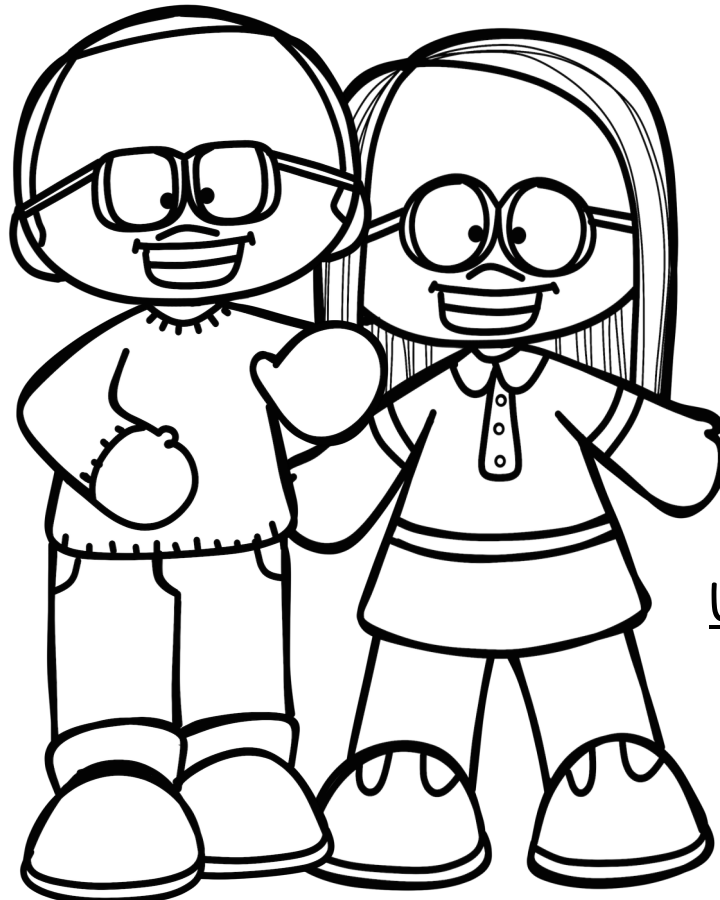

# NOUNS

A noun refers to a person, animal, place or thing.

TYPES OF NOUNS	EXPLANATION	EXAMPLE
Common noun	Peoples, animals, places or things in <u>GENERAL</u> .	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• teacher</li> <li>• cat</li> <li>• toilet</li> </ul>
Proper noun	A name that identifies a <u>PARTICULAR</u> person, place, or thing. (begin with capital letter)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Mr Tom</li> <li>• Kuala Lumpur</li> <li>• Honda</li> </ul>
Concrete noun	People and things that exist <u>PHYSICALLY</u> and can be seen, touched, smelled, heard, or tasted	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• dog</li> <li>• house</li> <li>• tree</li> <li>• chair</li> </ul>
Abstract noun	Ideas, qualities, and conditions - things that cannot be seen or touched and things which have <u>NO PHYSICAL QUALITY</u> .	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• truth</li> <li>• danger</li> <li>• happiness</li> <li>• time</li> <li>• friendship</li> <li>• humour</li> </ul>
Collective noun	<u>GROUPS</u> of peoples, animals, or things.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A flock of birds.</li> <li>• A group of teachers.</li> <li>• A bunch of flowers.</li> </ul>
Count noun	Something that <u>CAN BE COUNTED</u> .	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• three chairs</li> <li>• two books</li> </ul>
Uncountable noun	Something that <u>CANNOT BE COUNTED</u> . (does not have plural form)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• some sugar</li> <li>• some coffee</li> <li>• furniture</li> </ul>
