

ATTRIBUTIVE


 Stands before a noun and describes it. For eg:

The <u>red</u> bag is mine.

PREDICATIVE

 Stands after a noun and there's a verb separates it from the noun it describes. For eg:



Order of adjectives

When more than one adjective comes before a noun, the adjectives are NORMALLLY in this particular order:
